I also know that if we, as an individual, tried to hold all the problems of the world then we would be crushed under the weight. I know that as a group, this community is deeply compassionate and cares deeply for the state of the nation and the world. Thus, I would like to remind you that as individuals and even as a church, we cannot help everywhere. It is incumbent upon us to figure out where we would like to focus our energy so that we don't flounder under the weight of the struggles of the world.
